- (3) A restricted share unit award was granted on February 15, 2018 and vests in accordance with the terms of the Aon plc 2011 Incentive Compensation Plan: 33 1/3% of the award vests on each of the first through third anniversary of the date of grant.

- (4) A restricted share unit award was granted on February 14, 2019 and vests in accordance with the terms of the Aon plc 2011 Incentive Compensation Plan: 33 1/3% of the award vests on each of the first through third anniversary of the date of grant.
- (5) A restricted share unit award was granted on November 21, 2014 and vests in accordance with the terms of the Aon plc 2011 Incentive Compensation Plan: 20% of the award vests on each of the first through fifth anniversaries of the date of the grant.
