ADTRAN, Inc. held its Annual Meeting of Stockholders on May 9, 2012 (Annual Meeting). At the Annual Meeting, ADTRAN's stockholders (i) elected the seven people listed below to serve as directors for a one year term expiring at the 2013 Annual Meeting of Stockholders and until their successors have been duly elected and qualified (Proposal 1); (ii) approved, on an advisory basis, the executive compensation policies of ADTRAN as well as the compensation of the named executive officers (Proposal 2); and, (iii) ratified the appointment of PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP to serve as our independent registered public accounting firm for 2012 (Proposal 3).
