Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Represents a grant of restricted stock (40% time-based and 60% performance-based). The time-based portion will vest in three equal annual installments beginning on March 1, 2026. Vesting of the performance-based portion is dependent upon the extent to which two three-year performance metrics are achieved, with any earned shares vesting on March 1, 2028.
- (2) Represents a one-time retention grant of restricted stock with a one-year cliff vesting on March 1, 2028.
- (3) Shares withheld to cover the taxes due upon the vesting of equity awards.
- (4) Represents performance-based restricted shares or RSUs granted on April 4, 2022, which will be forfeited on April 4, 2025, for failing to achieve the three-year performance metrics.


