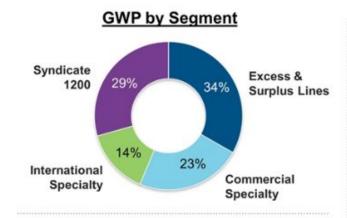

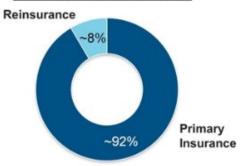

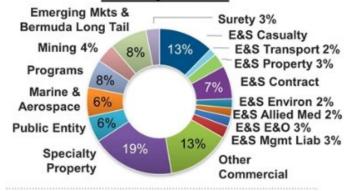
Argo Group Business Mix (\$2.0b in GWP)

GWP by Geography





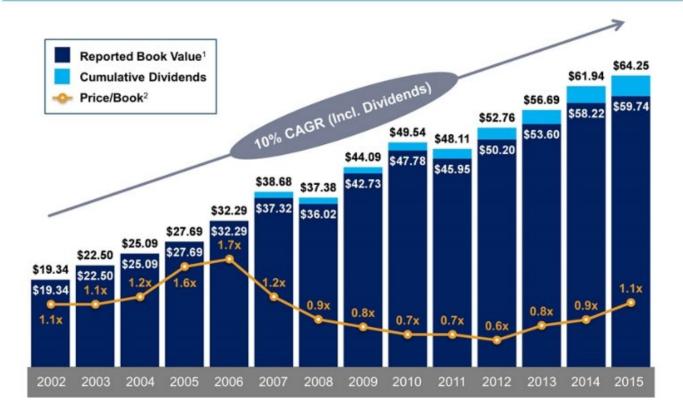

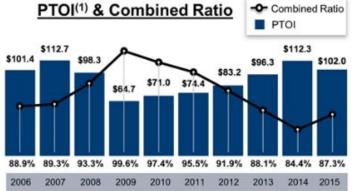
Excess & Surplus Lines Segment (34% of GWP)

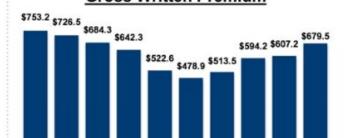

Gross Written Premium

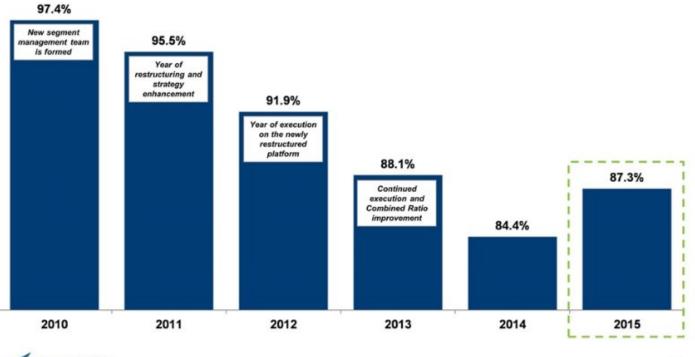

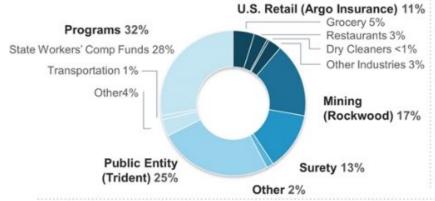

GWP by Business Unit (2015)

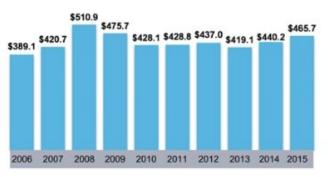

Gross Written Premium



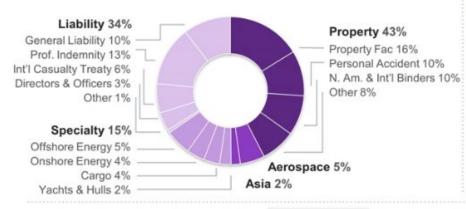

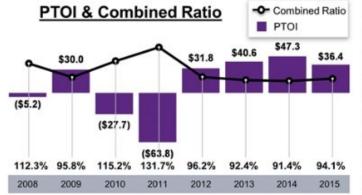
Syndicate 1200 Segment (29% of GWP)

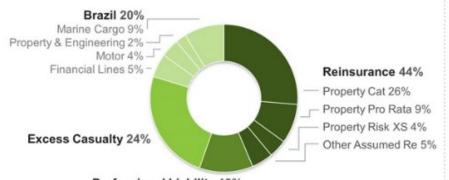

GWP by Business Unit (2015)



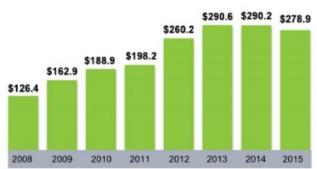

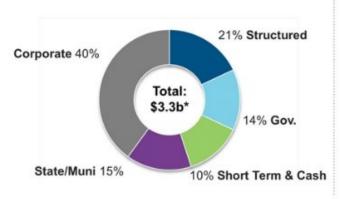

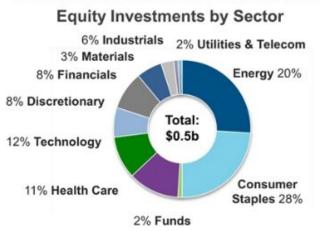

Stock Price Performance - Last 2 Years

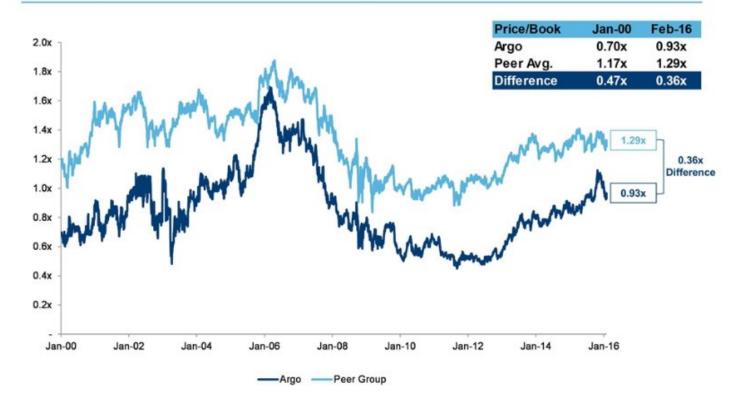
